Recycle Referral List

Recycling/disposal options:

The city of Appleton offers free bulk item pickup to residents each week opposite of recycling week. Some items may require a pre-purchased disposable tag. Please visit: Appleton.org/residents/garbage-recycling or call (920) 832-5277 to learn more

Hazardous waste:

Hazardous materials such as paint, cleaners, chemicals, automotive fluids, pesticides/insecticides, etc. call (920) 832-5277 or recyclemoreoutagaimo.org

Latex Paint disposal:

Latex paint is not hazardous since it is made from water. Consider donating usable paint to friends, neighbors, theater groups or housing assistance organizations.

For small amounts: remove the lid and let dry in the can. Stir the paint occasionally to speed dry.

Referrals to Moving Companies and Truck Rentals

For large amounts: line a box with a plastic bag. Place an absorbent material (kitty litter, sawdust, oil dry) on bottom, pour a layer of paint and repeat as necessary. Dispose of the dried paint and cans in the regular garbage.

Don't forget! Craigslist.org, freecycle.org, or simply curbing it with a "FREE" sign are alternate options for your donation
